



SCHOLARSHIP GUIDELINE 2027 - NEED BASED

Introduction

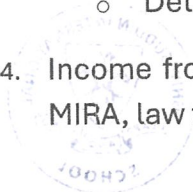
This scholarship is offered to students whose parents wish to enroll their children at Ghiyasuddin International School but may find it challenging to pay school fees.

And this scholarship supports students to continue their education at GIS.

- A total of three (3) scholarship seats will be awarded for the specified grade.
- This scholarship is exclusively for Maldivian residents.
- It is applicable from the beginning of the Academic Year 2027 and may be renewed annually, provided the student continues to meet the eligibility criteria.
- The scholarship covers the monthly tuition fee and a one-time admission fee charged by the school.

Eligibility Criteria

1. Open to Maldivian students eligible for admission to Grade 1 in the Academic Year 2027.
 - The child should be 6 years old by 31st December 2026 and not yet 7 years old. However, children who have completed preschool (UKG) by the end of the academic year 2026 will also be considered when reviewing registrations.
2. Parental/guardian income thresholds:
 - For students registered outside the Greater Male' area: annual income must not exceed MVR 420,000.
 - For students registered within the Greater Male' area: annual income must not exceed MVR 300,000.
3. Parents/guardians must submit:
 - Bank statements for all accounts.
 - Detailed income documentation.
4. Income from self-employment must be verified by an authorized body such as MIRA, law firms, Ministry of Economic Development and Trade, banks, etc.



Selection Process

- If the number of eligible applicants exceeds the available scholarships, a draw of lots will be conducted in the presence of:
 - Shortlisted parents
 - School Principal / Deputy Principal
 - Selected members of the PTA Executive Committee
- Applicants will undergo an assessment to check the literacy and numeracy level in:
 - Mathematics
 - Dhivehi
 - English
- Names of selected students will be published on:
 - The school website
 - The official Facebook page

Termination & Renewal

The scholarship may be discontinued under the following circumstances:

- If any information provided by the parents/guardians is found to be false or misleading.
- If the student is found to be receiving any other scholarship or financial aid for educational purposes.
- For students in Grades 1–6, renewal is based on continued compliance with the income threshold.
- For students in Grades 7–10, renewal requires:
 - A minimum score of 65% in final exams.
 - Continued compliance with the income threshold.
